This 222,000 square foot facility was designed for 1,400 students, from 9th to 12th grade. The 41 acre site includes baseball and softball fields, six tennis courts, concession stands and football practice fields with field-house. With the assistance of the City of Madison a 1,400 seat auditorium has been constructed for shared use by the school and community. Since Bob Jones High School's initial completion in the fall of 1996, there have been two additions: a classroom and bandroom addition as well as cafeteria addition have been completed.
